

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Please make sure that you fulfill the entry requirements for each port of your cruise.

If there is any doubt, please contact the consulate of said country to check the current entry requirements. Your Passport has to be valid at least **6 months** after the end of your voyage for all countries, regardless of destination. Please also make sure that you have enough free pages in your passport available.

The following entry requirements are only relevant to **German, Austrian and French citizens**:

Countries that require a visa:		Additional Information
<b>CANADA</b>	online	<a href="http://www.cic.gc.ca/english/visit/eta.asp">http://www.cic.gc.ca/english/visit/eta.asp</a> Starting Autumn 2016 an entry permit will be requested when arriving by air. For entering the country by sea or land, no ETA is necessary.
<b>USA</b>	online	<a href="https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov/esta/">https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov/esta/</a> The dates of birth should be advised to the airline. Travelers with double citizenship (one of which from Iraq, Iran, Syria or Sudan), as well as travelers who have visited above countries after 01.03.2011, need a visa.
<b>USA transit</b>	online	ESTA is required as soon as you enter the US. Even if you just have a connection flight via an US airport (transit). <b>This also applies for cruise sailings from San Juan and Barbados, an ESTA is required for those sailings.</b>
<b>CUBA</b>	onboard	Guests must purchase a tourist visa and Carnival will facilitate this at a cost of \$75 per person. The fee will be applied to their onboard Sail & Sign account and is non-refundable. The visa will be distributed at embarkation.

## PASSPORT AND VISA

All passengers need a machine-readably passport which has to be valid 6 months after the departure date and must have enough empty pages for entry- and departure marks.

All passengers under 21 years must be accompanied by a passenger who is 25 years or older. For family groups booking multiple staterooms, children may sail in a cabin without their parents or guardians, provided one child in the stateroom is a minimum of 16 years of age or older.

Please note that a notarized written consent for passengers under the age of 18 years is no longer required by Carnival Cruise Line. However, several countries require special documentation for children travelling without both parents; these requirements are subject to change without notice. In case of the sole right of custody, a running divorce, an adoption or similar circumstances, a certificate is necessary. With non-presentation boarding may be denied.

It is your responsibility to ensure that you possess the proper documents for all of the countries that you will visit. Please verify requirements with the immigration offices prior to your cruise.

All passengers need to fill in the Electronic System for Travel Authorization (ESTA) prior to their cruise online <https://esta.cbp.dhs.gov/esta/>.

The US government has decided that dual nationals holding passports issued by countries under the US Visa Waiver Programme and a passport issued by Iraq, Iran, Sudan or Syria require applying for a Visa when travelling to the US. Customers are not eligible to travel to the USA under the Visa Waiver Programme, anymore. Additionally, all customers who hold a valid ESTA and who have visited Iraq, Iran, Sudan or Syria since 1 March, 2011 will also require applying for a Visa and cannot travel under the Visa Waiver Programme, anymore. All VISA regulations are subject to change.

**Please contact the embassy of each port, to get information about VISA requirements.**

## **VACCINATIONS**

Regulations with regard to vaccination certificates and other health requirements for the various embarkation ports may vary by destination and change from time to time. It is the sole responsibility of the passenger to obtain and have available when necessary the appropriate valid travel and health documents such as vaccination certificates, that are necessary for air travel, disembarkation at the various ports of call and re-entry into the appropriate country of origin. Passengers who do not possess the proper documentation will be prevented from boarding the flight or vessel without refund of the cruise and will be subject to any fine or other costs incurred by Carnival Cruise Line which result from the lack of proper documentation.

For some Cruises with Carnival Cruise Line a Yellow Fever Vaccination is required. This Vaccination is also necessary if you have visited a risk area immediately before.

For further information please contact your doctor, the Institute of the Tropes or the Department for Foreign Affairs. In case of a new introduced vaccination regulation we will be sure to inform you.

### Travellers under 21 years:

- For tourists under 21 travelling alone, there are specific entry requirements for each country. We kindly ask you to contact the embassy/consulate for specific information.
- For underaged travellers with a family name different than their parents', a proof of family relation is required (e.g. a birth certificate).

**We recommend all passengers to carry a copy of their passport with them at all times.**

**Please make sure you have all current information about vaccinations as well. E.g. a Yellow Fever vaccination is required at some ports.**
